## Our Vision

Douglas County Libraries (DCL) elevates our community by inspiring a love of reading, discovery and connection.

Formed in 1990, we are the fourth-largest library system in Colorado, with seven locations serving two million visitors annually. Ranked for several years among the best-performing U.S. public library systems for the population it serves, DCL plays a vital role in the life of our community.

Douglas County Libraries lends nearly seven million books, DVDs, magazines, e-books and audiobooks every year. We offer a large collection of popular materials, reference materials and research tools, downloadable audio, video and e-books, wireless access, public internet stations, and friendly, professional staff. We also provide reading recommendations, test prep and proctoring, English language learning, technology tutoring, used book sales, and access to Douglas County history and community information.

We offer signature events for all ages, more than 75 Storytimes each week, book clubs, and a variety of interesting single events and series that engage, educate and entertain patrons of all ages. Study rooms, meetings rooms and event venues are available to the public.
